NAAC REPORT

The Institution completed its 1st accreditation cycle in Nov ,2016 and the validity of the same was up to 5th Nov,2021.In this regard ,the year 2021-22 was predominantly focused on completing the process of SSR uploading for re-accreditation for 2nd cycle by Dec,2021

The SSR was reviewed by inviting the expert members Dr Peeyush Pahade from IQAC Cluster India, Dr Koel, Principal and Mrs. Bhumika More, IQAC Member from SIES college Nerul, who gave valuable suggestions regarding documentation and data verification process.

The college applied for NAAC 2nd cycle process on 14th December, 2021 by submitting IQA along with initial fee payment. The same was accepted by NAAC on 16th December. The SSR was submitted on 27th January, 2022 by uploading all required documents and payment of first instalment fees.

The DVV clarifications were sought by NAAC on 16th Feb, 2022 and the same was submitted along with required proof of documents and 2nd instalment of fees which was accepted by NAAC.
