### Industry Visited:



- **Local Markets:** Exploring Jaipur's bustling markets allowed students to witness and appreciate traditional Rajasthani crafts and products.




- **Culinary Experience:** Sampling local Rajasthani cuisine enhanced the cultural experience, offering a taste of the region's culinary richness.
